It appears we have issues with the scanner part of the plotter in building. For a few days it was telling us we have to clean the scanner glass and white background because it couldn't read the calibration sheet correctly. After a few times of cleaning and trying again, it came up with two system messages stating a lamp needs to be replaced and the air filter needs to be replaced.

The error messages have since gone away. However, when making a copy, you can see a clear difference in the brightness of the different sections of the printout (I have it in my office), which leads me to believe that a bulb/lamp does need to be replaced.

Hoping we still have out service contract with them.
