Director's Report

The budget was briefly discussed; one truck – a 1983 Kodiak will have to be replaced.

Snow – a lot of the snow has melted recently. \$275,000.00 has been spent to date; some funds remain.

Potholes – there have been many this year due to the weather. Public Works is keeping on top of it. If there are any problems, please call them in.

Spring – the ground is saturated and field work can not begin yet. A lot of prep work is needed due to all of the snow this year. There is a lot of shrubbery damage, curb damage, etc.

Recycling – Bruce attended a meeting on the single stream recycling and this is anticipated to begin in July.

The State is letting Public Works finish Old Gate Lane. This will be a much more timely process and will help with drainage.

The Town Dock project is ready to go out to bid. The work is to be done over the summer.

Gulf Beach – moving of the sand. The DEP is to take the sand down/lower by the groin and move sand to replenish the beach.

The Saint Patrick's Day Parade will be on March 12th.

Concerns:

Bier asked about the potholes on Corona. Bruce stated that two holes were fixed.

Devon was briefly discussed. Some lights were out and many lightposts were replaced. The clock itself is working; the light and chime is not. There will be an informational meeting in April for Naugatuck Avenue drainage.

Vecharelli asked about West Avenue in front of JFK School; he has received complaints. Bruce stated that Westcott and Mapes is overseeing this project.
