Director's Report

Sidewalk projects are moving along. Aprons were discussed; some residents/business owners get work done by the contractor on site and private pay to the contractor and get the same rate. A regular side walk was put in at Gulf Beach; the crushed shells have been removed. Sidewalks that have been completed were discussed; some required state permits. Seaside Avenue was discussed. Collingsdale and Shadyside Lane will be done within the next couple of weeks.
