The meeting was called to order at 7:15 p.m.

Director's Report

- Gulf Beach Sand – started being moved today. This went through the DEEP. There is to be 1,000 yards of sand moved and it should be complete tomorrow. The larger project will begin next year.
- Paving is complete for the year. Residents of Wolf Harbor are pleased. Monroe Street – from Pumpkin Delight to Elton Street recycling is being used and then paved over. This process was reviewed. Sweeping continues; requests are being interspersed with the regular schedule as can be accommodated.
- Tree work continues; a lot of trees have fallen.
- Boardwalk was briefly discussed; it is becoming overgrown.
- The heat has been wreaking havoc with some of the buildings.
- Town Dock – work has begun and staying on schedule (Terry Contracting). It is hopeful that the work be completed by winter.
- Old Gate Lane work has begun; an island will be included in this project.
- West Avenue/Schoolhouse Road was briefly discussed.
- On 8/11/11 Channel 8 is doing a Town Greens Program and will be in Milford.
- The new recycling bins have begun to be distributed. There is one size only. Any questions should be directed to Public Works. This new system will take time for everyone to adjust.

Concerns

- Bier stated that 50 Bridgeport Avenue needs garbage pick up. Bruce stated that this was all set.
- German stated that he would like the trees downtown trimmed. Bruce stated that he will look into this.
- Oyster Festival preparation was discussed as well as garbage removal during and after. The HOPE Club, Interact Club, Key Clubs at the High Schools assist with this.

The next meeting will be on August 29, 2011.
