

Minutes of the Public Works Committee on July 27, 2009.

Due to the lack of quorum, the following was briefly discussed:

There will be no August meeting.

Both Nunno and Vetro received a complaint from a resident on Lawrence Avenue regarding a drainage problem with catch basins. Bruce stated that he went to this site last year and the problem is with the pipe. This was a Block Grant project years ago that was completed and inspected. There were paving issues as well. Bruce will look into it.

Nunno reported that a tree on Lawrence and Welche's Point Road was supposed to come down and it is still there. Vetro stated that he went there and notified the Police of the situation because he thought it was a line of sight issue; it is a huge tree. Bruce will look into this.

Nunno received a complaint from a Millwood Road resident. The benches on Trumbull Avenue need to be painted. Bruce will look into this.

Vetro stated that Vincent Marrone sent a letter regarding right of way in the Pond Point area. Bruce will look into this.

Director's Report

Oronoque Road – the drainage is pretty much all set. Public Works worked with Metro North on this project.

The beaches and garbage issues there were discussed.

The following festivals are coming up: Woodmont Day was this past week; Walnut Beach Day is this Sunday; the Oyster Festival is on 8/15/09 and the Irish Festival is in September.

Paving – three neighborhoods are being done. A discussion followed regarding roads.

There was a discussion on the Devon Revitalization Projects; the City is to maintain this once it is complete.

There was a complaint of water in the Point Beach area. Bruce went out and it was due to the tide.

Town Aide has not yet been approved by the Governor.

There being no further business to discuss, the meeting adjourned at 8:30 p.m.
