Due to a lack of quorum, the following was briefly discussed:

- The sand and salt has been delivered. The shed is full of mix as well as one full shed of salt and one full shed of sand.
- Leaf pickup continues.
- Drainage work continues. Oronoque Road by Zion Hill Road had a water problem; an underdrain was installed and has been completed.
- Bathrooms and water have been shut off for the season; some people are still using them even without water.
- The Town Dock preliminary plan has been updated. Bier was at a meeting on Thursday; the Harbor Commission has the plans and would like Bruce to attend the next months meeting. This project will go out to bond in 2011. The project will take a few months for completion.
- The Christmas Tree Lighting was a success.
- The UI Company revamped all of the street lights in town and some have been eliminated and some are being worked on.
- The conduit project with A T & T is ongoing; this is trying to connect everything downtown.
- Wampus Lane was briefly discussed; lights will be installed in the tunnel.
- Intersections by the Mall were discussed. The Mall paid for 2 intersections at a cost of \$3,000.00 each. This is the Don't Block the Box initiative to eliminate traffic gridlock. People will be ticketed if stopped mid intersection. Public Works made the signs for this project.

Concerns:

Joy discussed the Devon and Downtown lamp posts. The West Avenue sewers were discussed. Joy asked about Old Gate Lane. Bruce stated that this is still in the approval process.

The winter storm process was briefly discussed as well as the on call process.
