1 Tudor Road Building Committee SPECIAL MEETING December 6, 2022

The 1 Tudor Road Building Committee held a special meeting on Tuesday, December, 6, 2022, in the conference room at The Boys & Girls Club of Milford. Scott Marlow called the meeting to order at 3:30.

Consideration of Minutes of Organizational Meeting held November 15, 2022.

M. Altomare made a motion to formally approve meeting minutes after the appropriate revisions have been made, B. Garfield seconded motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Review of Schematic Floor Plan:

The committee reviews the schematic floor plan.

- The trade room will become an auxiliary gym which will have a double door entrance to outside and a storage closet will be added to the south of the room. The single door entrance to outside will be removed.
- An entrance door will be added to the board room which will allow access to the board room and kitchen.
- A door will be added to connect the teen and middle school room.
- Windows will be added to the teen room.
- The lockers from the Milford Rec will be moved and placed in the teen hallway.
- The storage closet in the girl's toilet room will either me removed and replaced with another stall or it will be made permanent.
- Potentially adding counters and tall cabinets for storage in the classrooms.
- There will be another sink added in the art room.
- The main entrance doors will be replaced with glass doors.

Review of Schematic Design Budget:

The committee reviews the schematic design budget. This is the final schematic estimate.

- Budget includes a breakdown of mandatory (estimated) project development costs which are listed as either ARPA grant costs or Federal grant costs, and optional costs.
- Mandatory costs total: \$3,605,622, optional costs total: \$8,905,500. The total estimated costs including construction fees (not including optional): \$4,215,254.
- Three heating, ventilating, and AC options were discussed. Committee must make final decision for determine final price
- Discussed possible options and pricing for solar panels

<u>M. Altomare made a motion to approve a structural analysis of the roof to see if the building can support PV panels. B. Garfield seconded motion. Motion carried unanimously.</u>

Review of Conceptual Ideas for The Site:

- Different tiling for the front desk and offices than for the classrooms
- Possibly add an emergency exit window to each classroom

Consideration of Payment Requisitions:
