I. PUBLIC INFORMATION SESSION ON THE LONG RANGE PLAN TO DATE

At 7:00 PM Ms. Glennon began a presentation exhibiting the work that has been done relative to the long range plan of the Milford Public Schools.

Key indicators of the study included: enrollment, facilities, programmatic needs, transitions/configurations and public input. Historical and projected enrollment numbers showed a decline of approximately 2,200 students between 2005 through 2020. She reviewed the process in which the Board used to gain an agreement of concepts. The Board is in support of:

- K-5 configuration, beginning in September 2015
- A system wide redistricting to rebalance enrollment at the elementary level
- Preschool classrooms in more than one site
- Close Harborside Middle School in 3-5 years when the planned renovation and expansion at West Shore Middle School is complete
- Implementation of new programming at all levels

Ms. Glennon shared some of the new programming being considered. She then indicated the board is mixed on whether or not to close an elementary school.

Ms. Glennon showed the proposed timeline that would begin pursuant to the Board's adoption of a plan at its October 13th Business meeting.

Ms. Glennon read the ground rules for comments before opening the floor up to speakers. Ms. Glennon asked for a motion.

Mrs. Fucci made a motion to come out of recess from the September 23rd Public Information Session. Mr. DeRosa seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

II. PUBLIC COMMENT

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Ten people offered comments ranging from programmatic changes, closure of an elementary or middle school, transportation and redistricting.

Ms. Glennon thanked them for their comments.

III. ADJOURNMENT

Mrs. Fucci a motion to adjourn. Mr. DeRosa seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
