Ms. Glennon called the virtual special meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. By a roll call, all Board members were present. Ms. Glennon then led the Board in the reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance.

II. COVID-19 UPDATE

Dr. Cutaia provided the Board with an update on ReStart 2020-2021. Following a brief recap since submission to the State on July 24th, she shared her plan to open schools in the fall will be to use a hybrid model, a mix of in school and distance learning. Students will go to school four days a week (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday) using a shortened day. One day (Wednesday) will be a full day of distance learning. She highlighted some advantages of this plan will:

- Give students and staff the opportunity to acclimate to a new way of schooling with a priority on relationship building and social/emotional learning.
- A daily schedule to be considerate of mask wearing and social distancing rules.
- Opportunity to experience newly reconstituted distance learning experience planned for 2020-2021 in preparation of the potential of full-time distance learning.
- Additional time for staff to plan together for a new instructional model which accommodates current protocols and practices.
- Allows us to "ease" into a potential full-time, in-person instructional scenario.
- With 100% of students returning to school, having Wednesday as a distance learning day will allow us the opportunity to disinfect and engage in deep cleaning of our facilities.
