4. Unfinished Business

- a) Purchase of 462 Oronoque Road property The purchase of this property was accepted by both Planning and Zoning and the Board of Alderman.
- b) Plan of Conservation & Development Bill and Carol met with Jocelyn Mathiasen, the new DPLU director. Jocelyn told Bill and Carol that the final draft of the Plan of Conservation and Development will not be ready until September 2012. There will be a sequence of meetings set up. The structure of these meetings has to be developed. Once these meetings are set up, there will be an opportunity for the Conservation Commission to have input into the plan. The Mayor's Open Space Advisory Committee is planning to request a list of items that have been acted on from the last plan ten years ago. Jocelyn is also looking into an online web discussion based on a town in Connecticut which enables the public to make comments on the Plan of Conservation and Development. Jocelyn also told Bill and Carol that different departments within the city are being cross trained so all departments are aware of the responsibilities of each department and to improve customer service.

e) Miscellaneous

Carol said she will follow up with Barbara Milton regarding the greenway buffer project.

Carol reported that the osprey are back at Gulf Pond.
