- 1. Call to Order/Roll Call** – Bill Poutray, Carol Dunn, Oden Seaholm, Dan Drago and Maureen Mauro.
- 2. Review Minutes** – Change to the November minutes. Item #3, 2<sup>nd</sup> paragraph, 2<sup>nd</sup> sentence change to “deer for period of two years”.
- 3. Public Comments** – No public comments.
- 4. Open Space Walks Schedule** – There will be a winter walk at Eisenhower Park in mid-March. Maureen Mauro will lead the walk.
- 5. Deer Tick Apparatus** – There was a discussion about the deer tick apparatus using corn to feed them. Deer brush against it and it kills ticks. Oden cautioned about deer integrating the apparatus.
- 6. Solomon Property** – Bill brought up the concern of a deer-hunting tree stand believed to be located on the Solomon property. Bill and Oden will go to the property and assess the situation.
- 7. Open Space Survey** – Bill spoke about the open space survey. It is being sent to 250 Milford residents to get their input about open space. The Mayor’s Open Space Committee is looking at possibilities of funding for open space.
