**Call to Order:** Mayor Richetelli called the meeting to order at 1705 hours. A quorum was present.

**1. Roll Call**

Commissioners Brennan and Smith made and seconded a motion that any position that come available for hire on or before July 29, 2010, the expiration date of the current list, shall be made from the current list. Motion carried unanimously.

Commissioners Healy and Smith made and seconded a motion to amend the agenda to include discussion about current recruitment. Motion carried unanimously.

Assistant Chief Zingaro explained to the Board his current recruitment plan. Discussion was held by all as to changes that can be made to the current recruitment process.

Commissioner Brennan mentioned the new maintenance truck that the Department bought. He explained that a boom is necessary to avoid injury, and explained the difference in electric and hydraulic booms.
