1. Point Beach – no report.

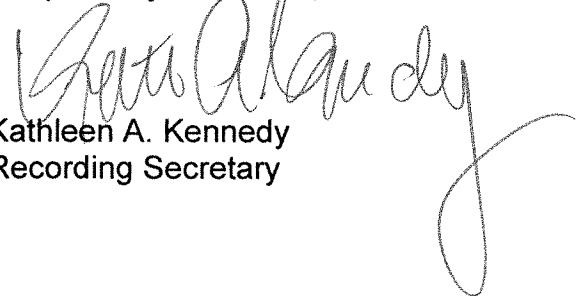
2. Milford Point Road – Asst. Director Johnson reported the project has been extended.
