III. Consideration of Minutes

Commissioner Healey provided a brief report concerning the punch list for the maintenance shed and certificate of occupancy for the clubhouse. It is expected everything should be wrapped up in the next month or two.

Commissioner Healey then reported a list of items the Planning Committee would like to begin looking into. He commented that the building is approximately 20 years and many items will be approaching the end of their life expectancy. Commissioner Healey stated he was requesting to start looking into the various items before they begin failing.

b) <u>Financial Advisor</u> —Commissioner O'Connell reported the amounts in the accounts as of August 10, 2016. Repair/Maintenance \$17,228.00; Secretarial Fees \$550; Water \$26,000; Fund 18 \$58,000; and Open Space \$1,409.
