Management Report

Mr. McNeil shared that the golf course is off to a great start, having consistent rounds since January. He reported that there were more rounds in February than in March. He stated that compared to last year, there is a 4% increase on rounds and 9% increase on revenue. Mr. McNeil brought up that improvements are needed for netting near the practice facility, and discussion ensued. Mr. McNeil shared the possibility of placing a tent on the grounds, discussion ensued about having a temporary tent for events. Mr. McNeil and Commissioner O'Connell will report back about the tent.

Report on Rounds – Mr. McNeil distributed the report on rounds and reviewed the numbers with the Commission.

New Business

Commissioner Veccharelli inquired about getting another cart for the golf course. Discussion ensued about storage options and maintenance. Chairman Amato appointed Commissioner Healey to investigate a new cart building.
