## **MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING HELD AUGUST 16, 2007**

- R. Post moved to accept the minutes with that one change, J. Beard seconded the motion, the members voted and the motion was unanimously carried.

### **D. PUBLIC COMMENTS**

- Honey Sacks of 10 Oyster Landing Road, Milford (Tele: 877-1101, [honeysacks@optonline.net](mailto:honeysacks@optonline.net)) attended the meeting to comment about the live-a-board boats docked at Oyster Landing. She commented on the ordinances and bylaws of the city and the dock association. She noted that no one is responding and that she needs help from the Commission. Chairman Montano noted that this very subject was brought to the Commission's attention last month. The Harbormaster noted that he is without comment, that he has done no research on the matter and has no authority over it. Mrs. Sacks stated that she spoke to Mr. Crabtree at P&Z and that he bounced it back to the Harbor Commission. Mrs. Sacks also stated that she exchanged correspondence with the President of the Dock Association (Giordano) and that he reported notifying the family(ies) who

denied living aboard the boat(s) in question. Mrs. Sacks showed pictures depicting the nuisance. Chairman Montano noted that he left the City Attorney a voicemail but has yet to hear back from her. Mrs. Sacks noted that she appreciates any help the Commission can lend her. J. Politi commented on the ordinance or lack thereof.

- R. Swift responded that its hard to calculate the benefit with the rate increase.
