Director's Report:

Mr. Swift noted the success of the Oyster Festival, Rotary Lobsterbake, and Labor Day for the Landing. Also, the weekend of Sept 15th was a hit with Ponous Yacht Club from Stamford, CT. Columbus Day is sold out with guests from Valley Yacht

Club and Harbor Valley Yacht Club.

Some seasonal employees will help out with rebuilding of floats this fall. Mr. Swift also stated that he was notified that there was an accident claim presented to the city for a fall that occurred on August 4,2012 on the marina premises.

The dredging project went out to bid, but there was only one bidder, Village Dock form Port Jeff, NYThe bid was for 9,000 CY at \$225,000, however there was also included in the bid mobilization costs of \$180,000 for a total of \$405,000.

The Commission was only authorized for \$250,000. There remains one more year on a three year permit.
