- John Ludtke has tended his resignation from the board; he will be moving to Arizona. An email was distributed, there will be a farewell gathering tomorrow night.
- The Habitat newsletter has some good articles regarding protecting wildlife and the IWA training is now available on their website.
- The Annual Report was reviewed. Bell asked about Cartegraph and DocStar. MaryRose stated that these are two programs that have been implemented by the Cityos MIS Department and she is confident that they are not proprietary. They can import databases; all records from 1989 to present are accessible. The ultimate goal is to have a single computerized permitting system. Right now there is only Public Works and IWA on the system.
- Fulco addressed minutes in general. Minutes are to be summaries and action taken, not verbatim. In the case of litigation, a recording would be transcribed verbatim.
