

Minutes of the special meeting and site walk of the Inland Wetlands Agency on June 19, 2019 at 1125 Oronoque Road.

A. Roll Call

Magnan called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. and reminded everyone that this is a Public Meeting and all questions must go through the Chair and there can be no discussion other than location of the proposed work in relation to the wetlands line. All other questions must be taken up at the regular meeting later this evening.

A motion was made by Connors, seconded by DeFlumeri that the MIWA act as a committee as a whole and to adjourn after the last question is answered. The motion carried unanimously.

B. Old Business

- 1. IW-A-19-040: 1125 Oronoque Road, Davis Holding Co.** – proposed redevelopment of sand and gravel pit to a manufacturing facility with construction, grading and drainage within 100' of a wetland or watercourse in the Housatonic River Watershed.

It was an overcast, mild day. Meagan Raymond oriented the site to the plan and noted the parameters of the site. The IWA viewed the SE boundary of Quarry Pond. Ted Hart noted that the pond is 8' below grade and there is no outlet to the pond. The stormwater pipe location was viewed and is 30' away from the pond; this was oriented to the plan. The small isolated wetland on site was viewed as well as the corner of the pond. The dock and pipe across the pond was viewed.

The IWA proceeded to manhole #3A and oriented the site to the plan. The IWA then proceeded to the proposed main entrance and scale house areas and oriented the site to the plan.

There being no further discussions, the meeting adjourned at 6:40 p.m.
