- Human Services 165 individuals; 437 family members were served. MYFS 154 Family Therapy cases, the prevention based piece had 732 people in it.
- The Rent Rebate Program has begun and appointments are being scheduled. A copy
 of the press release that has the schedule for the Senior and Disabled Housing Site
 Visits was distributed. The Farmers Market Food Voucher program will be
 coordinated with this upon receipt of the vouchers.
- The new Outreach Worker began employment a couple of weeks ago and is doing very well.
- The RENT A KID sign up was very successful and there were over 20 new families in attendance; bringing the current active list to over 170 youths.
- The Improvisations Theatre Group performed 3 times this past month at Elementary Schools on bullying and peer pressure. The final Family Fun Night for the summer was last Thursday night.
- The Mayor contacted Lisa stating that he wanted to run the Mayor's Youth Award this year. Lisa had informed him that MYFS could not run the program this year due to last years budget cuts and staffing issues over the past year. Therefore, per the Mayor's request, MYFS will run the award ceremony at the Westfield Post Mall Firework's Celebration on July 3rd. A discussion followed on the history and inception of this award.
- All other programs are status quo.

4. Fiscal Report

The financial report was reviewed and a motion was made by Kecko, seconded by Chapin to accept the report as presented. The motion carried unanimously.

5. Nominations

After some discussion, Chapin volunteered to be on the nominations committee.
