Report of the Investment Advisor

Mr. John Oliver Beirne presented the investment report for the month ending 3/31/15 and reviewed it with the Board. He stated that the Zesiger Capital portfolio has been liquidated. He stated that the fund is underweighted in mid and small caps. He stated that they would recommend taking 8%, approximately \$25,000,000.00 from Neuberger Berman and putting 2.7% in mid cap and 5% in small cap using an index fund. Mr. Mahoney moved that 8% of the overall fund be taken from Neuberger Berman and put into mid and small cap index funds. The motion was seconded by Mr. Elwell and carried unanimously.,

Mr. Cody stated that the spring manager meetings will e coming up and he encouraged all members to attend these meetings. Mr. Beirne stated that a new credit manager will be coming in to speak to the Board at another time. Mr. Cody stated the Board will need to review the guidelines and policy. Mr. Beirne stated that the asset allocation guidelines should be reviewed and possibly be revised.
