## **Report of the Investment Advisor**

Mr. Beirne presented his report for the month ending September 30, 2013 and reviewed it with the Board. He stated that they would recommend that a new manager be brought in for the emerging market sector. The portfolio is slightly underweighted in this area. Their recommendation would be 2 ½% of the portfolio for this investment. Mr. Beirne moved that 2 ½% of the portfolio be indexed to be managed by a manager to be determined for the emerging market portion. The funds will be taken from cash and put into an indexed fund.
