SEWER COMMISSION PUBLIC HEARING
February 26, 2020

The Sewer Commission of the City of Milford held a Public Hearing on Wednesday, February 26, 2020 in Conference Room C of the Parsons Government Center, 70 West River Street, Milford, CT.

Chairman Cooke called the meeting to order at 6 P.M. stating that Information will be presented by Westcott and Mapes, Inc. on the following projects:

**Gulf Pond Sanitary Pump Station Repairs
&
Lower Wepawaug “Stonebridge” Pond Sewer/Manhole Lining**

Chairman Cooke explained that public comments will be restricted to these projects only. He then turned the meeting over to Mark Davis, Westcott & Mapes, consultant to the Sewer Commission.

Mark Davis explained that the Gulf Pond Sanitary Pump Station Repairs includes replacing the 24 inch butterfly valve with a new valve on force main header, replace all four 4) 18-inch gate valves on the pump station lines, and design, materials, construction, construction administration and other related costs to the project. He explained that the bulk of the cost is for the bypass to conduct the repairs. He added that this project has been bonded for \$665,000. and approved by the Board of Alderman.

Mark Davis explained that the Lower Wepawaug “Stonebridge” Pond Sewer/Manhole Lining Project includes the installation of 204 linear feet of cured-in-place liner in the existing 16-inch cast iron sanitary sewer extending underneath Lower Wepawaug “Stonebridge” Pond, and design, materials, construction, construction administration and other replaced costs. He

added that this project has been bonded for \$110,000. and approved by the Board of Alderman.

Chairman Cooke closed the Public Hearing at 6:10 P.M.
