SEWER COMMISSION PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED SEWER USE FEE FOR 2020-2021

WEDNESDAY, MAY 26, 2021 - 6:00 P.M.

The Sewer Commission of the City of Milford held a Public Hearing, Wednesday, May 26, 2020, by videoconference (Zoom).

Chairman Lee Cooke opened the public hearing at 6:00 p.m.

Chairman Cooke called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

The Board of Sewer Commissioners will hold a public information hearing to determine if a sewer service fee in the amount of \$ 302.16 per modified equivalent unit is adequate to pay the costs of operation and maintenance, including replacement cost of the public wastewater treatment works for fiscal year 2021-2022 in accordance with Section 23-80 through 23-86 of the Ordinances of the City of Milford.

The modified equivalent unit is the minimum charge for connection to the sewer system. It applies to all single-family residences, (including condominium units and apartments), and to non-residential users such as individual stores, storage facilities and offices up to 3,000 square feet.

Large users are billed proportionally in modified equivalent units, rounded up to the nearest whole unit. Industrial users are billed a surcharge if the discharge exceeds 350 milligrams per liter of biochemical oxygen demand or 350 milligrams per liter of total suspended solids.
