

CITY OF MILFORD
SEWER COMMISSION PUBLIC HEARING
PROPOSED SEWER USE FEE FOR 2019-2020
May 29, 2019

The Sewer Commission of the City of Milford held a regular meeting on Wednesday, May 29, 2019 in Conference Room C of the Parsons Government Center, 70 West River Street, Milford, CT. Chairman Lee Cooke opened the public hearing at 6:00 p.m.

Chairman Cooke called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

The Board of Sewer Commissioners will hold a public information hearing to determine if a sewer service fee in the amount of \$ 323.52 per modified equivalent unit is adequate to pay the costs of operation and maintenance, including replacement cost of the public wastewater treatment works for fiscal year 2019-2020 in accordance with Section 23-80 through 23-86 of the Ordinances of the City of Milford.

The modified equivalent unit is the minimum charge for connection to the sewer system. It applies to all single family residences, (including condominium units and apartments), and to non-residential users such as individual stores, storage facilities and offices up to 3,000 square feet.

Large users are billed proportionally in modified equivalent units, rounded up to the nearest whole unit. Industrial users are billed a surcharge if the discharge exceeds 350 milligrams per liter of biochemical oxygen demand or 350 milligrams per liter of total suspended solids.

Citizens Comments:

Statements limited to the legislative function of the Sewer Commission. The time limit granted to each speaker shall be three (3) minutes. Residents, taxpayers or electors may address the Commission. There was no one present to speak.

Chairman Cooke called for a motion for the Sewer Use Fee in the amount of \$ 323.52
Commissioner Castignoli made a motion to approve the Sewer Use Fee of \$ 323.52 with
Commissioner Bier seconding the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Chairman Cooke called for a motion to adjourn at 6:04 pm. Commissioner Castignoli made a
motion to adjourn with Commissioner Bier seconding the motion. The motion carried
unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 6:04 pm.
