E. TREE WARDEN REPORT

F. STREET TREE MATTERS

- Seaside Avenue Trees: We are waiting for the evaluation letter the stone wall is an issue (costs).
- Victory Circle: Milford Trees, Inc. planted 9 trees in the fronts yards of the neighbors on that street. The neighbors asked for a "block-wide" planting. Kate Orecchio received a phone call from Tree Warden Rich Tomasco saying the tress should go on the snow shelf it is not a planting strip. Kate indicated that she would inquire of a professional arborist as to what trees could be planted there.

G. ARBORETUM

- A sign at the Arboretum is now missing (which blew away in one of the recent storms) across from Lafayette Street that needs to be replaced.
- Steve Wing has the Signs for the trees in the Arboretum are spring-loaded ID tags to be installed. Most probably a weekend day will have to be scheduled now in order to install them.

H. OPEN GRANTS

I. TREE NURSERY

- Milford Trees, Inc. was awarded a DEEP Grant in the amount of \$3,000.00 this can help re-organize the Nursery, including placing the trees on a stake line instead of them sitting in mulch.
- The "Mile-A-Minute" vine is still an issue, and bothering a potted Dogwood there.

L. INTER-AGENCY REVIEW MATTERS

M. SPECIAL NOTE

 Kate Orecchio Brought to our attention that Greenhouse Gas levels have increased by 6% last year, as reported on Page 11 of the Connectiocut Post. The Tree Commission believes this should be taken into consideration and therefore more trees should be planted, especially since we've lost so many trees due to Hurricane Irene and the recent Autumn Nor'Easter.
