The Commission discussed the vacant lot next to Harrison's. Attempts will be made to improve the lot with plantings. Any

action depends on the willingness of the owner to permit activity.

VIII. New Business

Mr. Gregory noted that the Devon project is coming to an end. The Devon Revitalization Committee is thinking of forming a business association that would carry on various activities. He also noted that the Walnut Beach Enhancement Committee is moving ahead with the dune crossing redo. In response to a question, he said that the sidewalks at the end of Naugatuck Avenue are the subject of an education and political program to convince the powers to be that the sidewalk could be widened.

The issue of Farmer's Markets was discussed. There are three in Milford now, one at Treat's on Wednesday afternoons, one downtown at Agro's, and one in Devon at the parking lot next to Al Dente's.

The issue of Sonic's location in Orange was discussed. This was not something that the City could have changed.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:10 a.m.
