Emergency Management: The department had a meeting with the Mayor to discuss flooding and flooding awareness. Current flood monitors are obsolete. The department together with the City is looking into new technology to help monitor coastal flooding.

Year End Summary: The Chief indicated statistical summaries of 2019 fire department calls for service were included in the Commissioner's packets. The Chief discussed some of the statistical data with the Board. Following the discussion, Chairman McGrath asked if false alarms were recorded in the statistics and if there were fines levied for repeated false alarms. The Chief indicated that the information was in the discussed stats and that fines have not been assessed in sometime. It was noted by Chief Begley that the Mall is a location with frequent

false alarms. This was supported by Commissioner Smith who noted that there are frequent false alarms at the gym he attends at the mall. Chairman McGrath also asked the Chief about the Motorola Radio grant. Asst. Chief Fabrizi noted that the department was in the process of replacing department radios with the grant money.
