Chairman's Report-R. Brennan

- Spoke with Mayor regarding the items he had Bev emailed to everyone
- Feedback from J. Nash, Community Development regarding the Tiki Boat. The cost is \$3,200 and the City will sponsor ½ of that through the economic plan, we just need to get him a contract.

Director's Report –James Donegan

- Two and half weeks in position, worked with Ray Swift on the system and operations, docks are in, grounds are looking good, the baskets are up over the bridge which is paid for by the Oyster Festival committee. Seasonal staff is back. No wake buoys went in.
- Went over financials/accounting with Bev and training a bit on system
- Reservations this weekend, some lost and then about ½ filled up again, so decent number for first weekend.
- Corona virus policies to Operate Safety from DEEP, DECB and City are broken into 3 parts:
 - O Staffing what they need to do for social distance, masks, hand washing procedures, cleaning equipment
 - o Buildings staff only in dock office, working from the window, one person per shift in dock office surfaces wiped down, radios cleaned after use. Building will remain closed

- for showers and heads advises people when the call regarding reservations, no one has issue so far
- o Working with guests regarding items within property being open/closed like patio areas for barbecues and keeping to no more than 5 in group, social distancing policies.
- R. Oliver suggested the policies be posted on the property. J. Donegan will put some posters from the CDC/State on the property. R. Brennan questioned the kids helping the boats land, for which Mr. Donegan explained they have masks and are at least 6 ft away. N. Bennett explained she sees no problem with this.
- N. Bennett made a motion to approve the outlined 3 parts, with D. Kubek seconding the motion. The motion carried unanimously.
- Discussion regarding pump out at landing and some PVC needing replacement. N. Bennett will get J. Donegan the information regarding refunds from Federal funds administered by State DEEP

Harbormaster's Report-B. Kurlya

- He obtained copy of the grant with the proposed allocations, not approved yet and still has to go for bonding. We did not get anything, however, Representative Maroney put in a request to finish Founders Walk for 2 million.
- They foreclosed on the abandoned boat and have the title, and will put it out for auction
- Army Core dredging is plotting along.
- Tiki boat, contacted Toni Weeks about insurance
- R. Oliver added that he needs to get in touch with Steven Johnson about the sign being returned to the Gulf Street bridge, ie. Wildlife area, no Jet Skis..... He explained that we could help with a boat to get the sign up, and he will see if Public Works can make it.

Deputy Harbormaster's Report -L. Henchman

• Everyone is paid except for 2 stragglers – got 3 new sailboats – deep water full, 4-5 open in the shallow area. All good.
