Maintains, lubricates and packs trash, sludge and sewage pumps.

Assists with daily tasks as necessitated by workload; performs a variety of skilled mechanical maintenance and repairs to equipment to ensure proper operation.

Maintains electric motors and gear drive equipment.

Performs maintenance and repairs to process equipment.

Performs electrical maintenance and carpentry as needed.

Maintains a variety of plant engines; fits bearings, grinds valves and performs periodic general overhauls.

Operates boilers and heat exchangers.

Maintains repair logs, spare parts inventory and other associated records.

Performs related work.
