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#### D. **New Business**

1. IW-A-17-015: 20 Westmoor Road, Sharlene Adams - proposed single family home with construction and grading within 100' of a wetland in the South Central Shoreline Watershed.

This item is on the agenda for the first time and can be heard at the 5/3/17 meeting.

2. IW-A-17-016: 16 Westmoor Road, Sharlene Adams - proposed single family home with construction and grading within 100' of a wetland in the South Central Shoreline Watershed.

This item is on the agenda for the first time and can be heard at the 5/3/17 meeting.

#### E. **Old Business**

1. Modification IW-M-16-045: 553 West Avenue, Grillo Services, LLC - proposal for modification to fire access road for approved 342 apartments in two buildings with associated parking, access drives and grading. Modification is for work within 150' of wetlands in the Beaver Brook Watershed.

MaryRose reported that this is a proposal by Grillo Services to modify the permit issued last year for 342 apartments in two buildings with associated parking, access drives and grading. The applicant is applying to modify the site plans to address concerns by the Fire Department. The modification proposes a mostly 28' wide fire access road composed of pervious asphalt to allow drainage and filtration through the fire access road. The increase in road surface area is to the Northwest in an area that was already proposed to be disturbed, towards the proposed developed area of the property.

The IWA scheduled a public hearing for the modification request on 5/3/17. The Public Hearing has been rescheduled to 5/17/17 due to the applicant failing to send out notices. The applicant will be submitting details on the proposed Fire Road, information requested on the Fire Departments requirements and the professional wetland scientist's review.

No action taken.

2. Violation IW-V-16-027: 1646 New Haven Avenue, Judith K. Rosehill – deposition of soil and material with work in and within 100' of a wetland or watercourse in the South Central Shoreline Watershed without permit.

MaryRose reported that there is no new information on this violation; she is waiting on input from DEEP-OLIS. She received a call from Mr. Rosehill who is concerned about soil eroding from his rear yard. She emailed his concerns and suggested solutions to John Gaucher at DEEP and is awaiting his reply. No action taken.
