b) GATA Grant – Chairwoman Flannery reported the GATA Grant is due July 15. She stated she would have more details for the June meeting.


c) Summer Meeting Schedule – Chairwoman Flannery stated the Committee would meet in June and July and typically take the month of August off and reconvene in September.
