Unfinished Business

A. Tree Commission Report – discussion ensued regarding the hopes to not only send out an annual letter to the residents/homeowners in the District but also to include a letter from both this body and the Tree Commission regarding removal of trees in recent time and the hopes of replacing those trees appropriately. The letter would explain the trees have been donated by the Milford Tree Commission and said trees would not be placed on the curbside of the sidewalk but in the homeowners' property (lawn).

Mr. Paulson and Mr. Becker made and seconded a motion to include in the annual mailing to residents/homeowners of the District a letter explaining the process to be used to replace curbside trees that had previously been removed; further authorizing Mrs. Jones to alter the verbiage of the letter after follow up discussion with the leadership of the Tree Commission. It was suggested by Mr. Paulson that the annual letter to be mailed go out on city letterhead.

Ms. Kennard questioned how many letters would be involved and she was told approximately 127.

B. Letter to Residents regarding need for COA – Following review of the revisions and suggested changes to be made to the annual letter, it was agreed that all of the revisions and comments would be acceptable. It was noted the letter should reference the fact that pertinent documents for the Historic District #2 including COA, rules and other necessary forms can be found on the city's website.

Mr. Paulson and Mr. Becker made and seconded a motion to accept the letter to be mailed to residents/homeowners in the Historic District #2 with the final revisions as noted. Motion carried unanimously.
