July 5 at 2pm

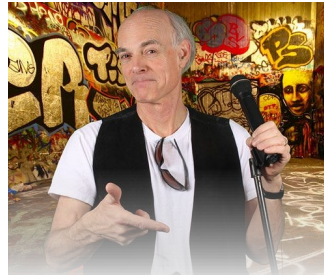
