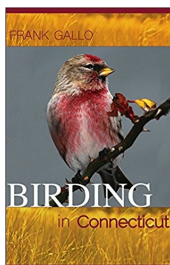
## Make Music Milford Thursday, June 21

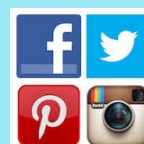
