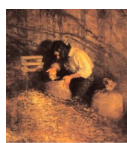
Bald Eagles: Richard Taylor September 19 at 7pm

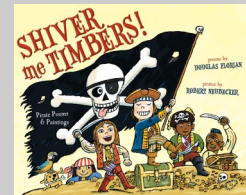
