November 10 at 2pm

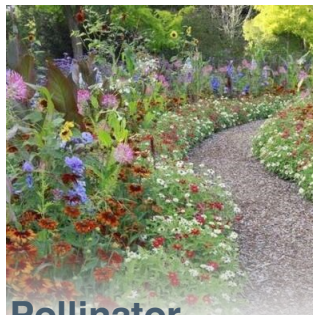

The drama continues as Nikki and her bandmates get ready to embark on a concert tour only to discover that her frenemy, MacKenzie, is also along for the ride.



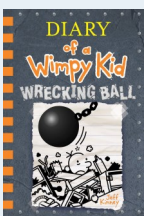
***Secret Hero Society: Field Trip Disaster* by Derek Fridolfs**
