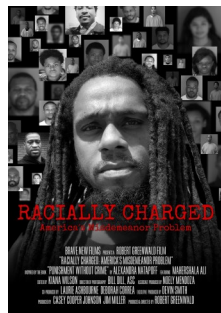

Racially Charged: America's Misdemeanor Problem via Zoom *

Milford Library and Milford Speaks Out will present a documentary that addresses criminal justice. This film exposes how our country's history of racial injustice evolved into an enormous abuse of criminal justice power. 13 million people a year are abused by this system. Through first person accounts of those charged under the Black Codes of the Reconstruction era, paralleled with the outrageous stories of people trapped in the system today, the film brings to light the unfolding of a powerful engine of profits and racial inequality. With the emergence of the Black Lives Matter movement, this film provides historical context and examines America's history of racist oppression. Former Milford Alderman Bryan Anderson will lead a discussion following the film. Milford's Chief of Police, Keith Mello, will be joining the discussion.
