Tuesday, September 14 at 7pm via Zoom

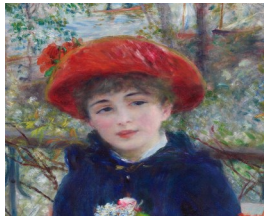
