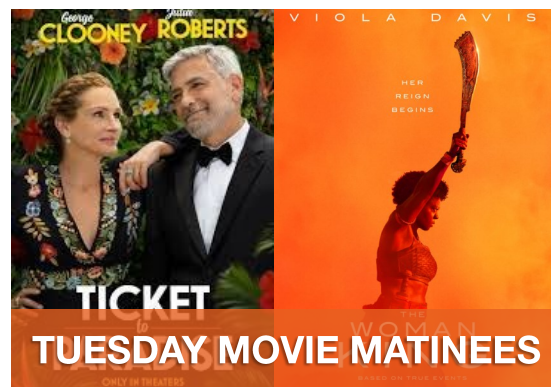
CELTIC MUSIC WITH JEFF SNOW
