"IMPOSSIBLE HISTORIES" WITH AUTHOR HAL JOHNSON

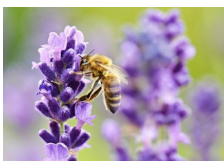
Saturday, March 18 at 2pm
