# **Committee Reports**

(a) Asset Allocation Committee

Mr. Cody stated that a meeting was held with Merrill Lynch and their Hedge Fund Development & Management Group. The portfolio already includes hedge funds with Merrill Lynch Hedge Access. HFDMG is offering a more comprehensive hedge fund product with greater diversification. John Beirne proposed that the Board move the current alternative investments (Campbell & ML Hedge Access) into this new program. The Group promises to accommodate the specific goals that we request. This would reduce the risk of hedge fund investment while increasing the return. This would also result in a reduction in fees. Mr. Cody stated that they would work with the Asset Allocation Committee to set up the goals for the fund. Mr. Shea was concerned that we are getting too much into this. He was also concerned with how this will effect the guidelines.

Mr. Cody moved that both the Campbell and Merrill Lynch Hedge Access money be put into a new Merrill Lynch Hedge Fund Development & Management Group Bespoke account with a 1% fee plus a 5% performance kicker. The motion was seconded by Mr. Elwell and carried unanimously.

Mr. Cody moved that \$6,000,000. from Boyd Watterson REIT Fund be moved into Neuberger Berman Large Cap Value (Strauss Group). The motion was seconded by Mr. Schempp and carried unanimously.

Mr. Shea felt that it was important to get the alternate investments back to 15% and stay within the guidelines. Mr. Sartor stated that this will be referred to the Asset Allocation Committee and Board action is not needed on re-balancing of the portfolio. Mr. Cody stated that they will look at adjusting the guidelines or re-balancing them.
