## Miscellaneous:

(a) Hooker and Holcombe Retiree COLA study

Vice Chairmen Elwell and the Board reviewed the Hooker & Holcombe letter dated October 9, 2017

with the proposed ad hoc COLA increases. The Board discussed at length considering increases for retirees that retired between 2000 – 2009 instead of 2000 – 2015 as noted in the October 9, 2017

letter. Mr. Hedman made a motion to make a recommendation for ad hoc COLA increases to the Board of Alderman as follows:

<u>1980 – 1989 \$120.00 annual increase</u> <u>1990 – 1999 2% increase</u> <u>2000 – 2009 1% increase</u>

Mr. Mahoney seconded the motion and all were in favor. The Board will ask Hooker & Holcombe to recalculate the City's required one-time lump sum contribution based on the proposed 2000 – 2009 group and provide a revised letter to the Board with the new calculations. The Board will provide said revised calculations to the Board of Alderman with its recommendation.

## Report of Investment Advisor

Mr. J.O. Beirne highlighted the September 30, 2017 Performance Summary.

Mr. J.O. Beirne reminded the Board of their meeting with Boyd Watterson last month and reviewed the option of investing in the Boyd Watterson State Government Fund (GSA Fund). If the Board is interested in investing, his recommendation would be to invest \$3M in this fund. Mr. Mahoney made a motion to invest \$3M in the Boyd Watterson State Government Fund (GSA) II. Mr. Hedman seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Mr. J.O. Beirne reminded the Board of their previous discussions regarding the Goldentree Fund. His recommendation is to invest \$10M. Mr. Hedman made a motion to invest \$10M in the Goldentree Fund. Mr. Mahoney seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Mahoney asked if any of our money managers would be presenting to us next month. Mr. J.O. Beirne will work to coordinate a meeting.

The meeting adjourned at 7:26 p.m.
