Financial Report:

<u>City of Milford Pension Fund Financial Statements for the period 7/1/20 – 9/30/20 were distributed to the Board.</u>

Hooker & Holcombe:

S. Lemanksi presented the pension analysis reports prepared by Hooker & Holcombe.

The first report examined the status of the City of Milford Pension Plan comparing the current funding policy (employer contributions based on increasing the prior year contribution by 15%) versus employer contributions at 100% of the Actuarial Determined Employer Contribution (ADEC) annual amount. This retrospective analysis covered FY2015 through FY2020.

The second report provides a 10-year projection though fiscal year ending 2031, comparing the same two funding assumptions and applying annual rate of returns at 7.50% and 7.20%.

Chairman Kimmel will set up a meeting with Mayor Blake to discuss the data.

Report of Investment Advisor:

- J.O. Beirne presented the results of the pension fund as December 31, 2020.
- J. Beirne reviewed slides pertaining to the value of the U.S. dollar and investment results.
