Amendment: #3-19 Self Storage Usage and Facilities

Mr. Sulkis explained that the City is proposing this to create new regulations for self storage facilities. He said Community

Development Director Julie Nash previously advised the board that she has had multiple inquiries to place self storage facilities along the Boston Post Road and in other prime retail districts. She has stated that these facilities do not generate business in areas zoned for doing exactly that. Mr. Sulkis said the City would like to limit these facilities to areas with less traffic, preferably zones already approved for warehousing use. Mr. Quish asked what the tax revenue difference is between a self storage facility and that of a retail location; Mr. Sulkis said he would consult the Assessor for an approximate comparison. He clarified that the Amendment under discussion would allow use in the HDD zone only. Mr. Sulkis and Mr. Quish discussed the format of the Amendment and various zones included or excluded. Mr. Marlow initiated discussion on future allowed locations for Self Storage facilities.

Mr. Quish motioned to **approve** that the Amendment be submitted the motion to the full board; **Mr. Marlow** seconded; the motion **passed** unanimously.
