On November 1, 2023, officers were dispatched to a Village Road residence for a 911 call. The victim stated that they got into an argument with Micalizzi. Micalizzi violently grabbed the victim's purse from them and took their phone when they were attempting to call the police. Micalizzi dragged the victim forward until they hit the door frame and fell forward to the ground hitting a plastic moving bin and then the floor. The victim went after Micalizzi who had left the room and struggled to get their purse back. Micalizzi let go of the purse, causing the victim to fall into some boxes and the wall. Micalizzi left the house prior to the officer's arrival. He later returned and spoke to the officers. During the investigation, it was determined that Micalizzi had an active protective order, which he had violated. He was taken into custody and charged accordingly.
