RESOLUTION RE: CASH ADVANCE FOR UPS BATTERIES AT THE MILFORD POLICE STATION

- WHEREAS, the State of Connecticut Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection Division of Statewide Emergency Telecommunications has approved the Milford Police Department's Capital Expense Grant application for the purchase/replacement of UPS batteries at the Milford Police Station in the amount of \$16,293.75; and
- WHEREAS, funds are currently needed in the amount of \$16,293.75 to purchase said UPS batteries to be installed and located at the Milford Police Station; and
- WHEREAS, it is desirable that cash in the said amount be advanced from the General Fund in anticipation of receipt of the State of Connecticut Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection Division of Statewide Emergency Telecommunications Capital Expense Grant funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Milford as follows:

- 1) That the Director of Finance on notification of project approval by the State of Connecticut is hereby authorized to advance cash from the General Fund in an amount not to exceed \$16,293.75; and
- 2) Repayment to the General Fund shall be made immediately upon receipt of the State Connecticut Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection Division of Statewide Emergency Telecommunications Capital Expense Grant funding.

The Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection Division of Statewide Emergency Telecommunications has received a Capital Expense Grant application and commitment letter to fully fund the purchase/replacement of a **UPS Batteries** from the Milford Police Department. The request meets funding requirements in accordance with Sec. 28-24-12a of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies as well as the policies established by DSET for the SFY 2023 – 2024 Capital Expense Grant. As a result, your request for funding is eligible for reimbursement.

Each regional emergency telecommunications center and funded municipality is eligible for up to 20% of their annual subsidy for reimbursement of capital expenditures related to emergency communications, subject to availability of funds. Information provided in your application and the proposal from Eaton notes the total cost for the proposed expenditure is \$32,587.50. Your request for a waiver of the three bid procurement rule is granted because the vendor has a history of trusted service with your department.

DSET will reimburse your organization up to \$16,293.75 (50.0%) for this project. The reimbursement will be provided if you submit invoices and proof of payment within 120 days from the date of this letter. Exceptions may be made, but requests must be sent in writing and are subject to DSET approval. Do not hesitate to contact me if more time is needed.

The Rogers Avenue Pump Station Upgrades bid came in at \$3,444,900. The Construction expense account 2811-P500000-6100000 has a balance of \$2,400,000 with an unallocated contingency of \$629,000.

I am requesting an allocation transfer of \$600,000 from the Emergency Reserve in the Sewer Fund for the Rogers Avenue PS Upgrades Construction Project.

This should cover the construction of the project and allow for change orders should they occur.
