Ald. Casey asked if the minimum number of parking spaces is still required, but any parking spaces with an EV charging station must be above-ground. Attorney Berchem stated that is correct and reviewed the requirements of the public act and proposed


ordinance . Ald. Casey asked what would happen if an underground parking garage was to be constructed with EV charging stations. Attorney Berchem stated it would require an exemption. He stated this is a public safety issue. Discussion ensued concerning the safety risks.
