# CITY OF MILFORD SEWER COMMISSION PUBLIC HEARING February 25, 2015

# INDIAN RIVER INTERCEPTOR PROJECT COMPLETION DARINA PLACE SANITARY SEWER REPLACEMENT ROCK STREET AND WELCHS POINT ROAD PUMP STATION RENOVATIONS

Public Comments will be restricted to these projects only.

Chairman Carroll turned the meeting over to Ray Macaluso.

### DARINA PLACE SANITARY SEWER REPLACEMENT

Mr. Macaluso presented that the Petrified Clay Sewer Pipe located on Darina Place was installed sometime around 1947 referring to a map showing the location of the pipe. The Mayor worked with the Board of Finance, Board of Alderman on the bonding for the project. The sewer project will be performed prior to the installation of sidewalks and curbs and pavement of the road. The street is tight and we came up with a low impact solution for the old clay pipe. The new technology is pipe lining which lasts approx 50 years, and there is almost no digging. Wastewater will TV (a small camera inserted into the pipe) to determine the condition of the pipe in the road as well as the laterals to the homes. The laterals going to each property will be lined so long as the existing pipe is up to the 6 inch standard. If the pipe is not up to 6 in. standard a new lateral pipe will installed up to property line at the city expense and it will be the owner responsibilities to have a contractor connect it. He added this is a City Project and will be managed by the City and he is only consulting should they need his

assistance. A qualified contractor will actually do the work and the neighbors will be notified of the dates. A bond will be posted by the contractor and held for one year, for which the contractor is 100% liable for his work and any damage to properties should this occur. Several homeowners inquired on the project for which Mr. Macaluso answered their questions and concerns. Mark & Kathy Hoffman, 10-12 Darina PI; Frank & Sandra Mossman, 51 Darina PI; Deana Jacobs, 14 Darina PI; Diana Nytko, 7 Darina PI; Carl Kaufman, 15 Darina PI; Ryan Anderson, 49 Ingersol Road, Board of Alderman, stated he is in support as the Board of Alderman has discussed the need for the infrastructure to be addressed and very excited to see the upgrades to this street.
