

## Instructions to reprint vehicle registration

Step 1: visit [WWW.CT.GOV/DMV](http://WWW.CT.GOV/DMV) and select “View all online services” under “Services available online – at your convenience

Step 2: Under “vehicle services” Select “Reprint registration certificate (Individuals and Organizations)”

#### Vehicle services

Cancel registration and license plates	Pay emissions test late fee
Change address	Renew registration
Check property tax, insurance, emissions, and other compliance issues	Replace damaged license plates
Look up registration status	<b>Reprint registration certificate (Individuals and Organizations)</b>

Step 3: Select “Online (individuals)” or “Online (organizations), then “Reprint”

**Online (individuals)** & **REPRINT NOW (INDIVIDUALS)**

or

**Online (organizations)** & **REPRINT NOW (ORGANIZATIONS)**

Step 4: Enter requested information which will allow you to reprint your registration. The registration comes up as a PDF which can be saved or printed.
